The art will be featured in a showing in the Monet Exhibition Room (2) of the Melwood Arts and Entertainment Center at post-party for the St. James Art Fair. The Oct. 3 post party runs from 4-9 p.m. and is hosted by Everything But The House. The auction for items runs Sept. 30 – Oct. 6 at EBTH.com.
